

Create seed bombs

Creating seed bombs is a good way to spread wildflower seeds and to create wildflower meadows. Meadow wildflowers that are suitable include: Birdsfoot Trefoil, Buttercup, Common Knapweed, Red Clover and Oxeye Daisy.

Step 1: collect materials

- Peat-free compost
- Meadow flower seeds
- Water
- Mixing bowl
- Clay or powdered clay



Step 2: put compost, seeds, water and clay in a bowl



Step 3: mix until it can be rolled into balls



Step 6: wait for the seeds to grow and flower.



Step 5: throw the seed bombs into your garden or green spaces



Step 4: roll into ball
