Answer: Central Park

What is it? Railway viaduct

Information: It is made up of 18 arches and was built in 1842 by the Eastern Counties Railway.

Answer: Central Park (between Bell Meadow and Sky Blue Pasture)

What is it? Bridge panels (called reflections)

Information: The panels were installed when the bridge was put in place in 2019. They represent the activities taking place in the park. The artist that created them is Anuradha Patel.

Answer: Central Park

What is it? Pedestrian stone bridge over the River Can

Information: Grade II listed Mid twentieth century reinforced concrete pedestrian bridge over the river Can, replicating the Stone bridge in High Street

Answer: Central Park (Bell Meadow)

What is it? War Memorial

Information: Memorial to remember those killed from the Essex Regiment during the Boer War (1899-1902).

Answer: Central Park (Sky Blue Pasture)

What is it? Park People

Information: Steel sculptures with calligraphy representing the people of Chelmsford.
